KidSport Assistance Information

The Genesis Centre and CNEU are proud to showcase KidsSport Calgary, who offers grant support to those families facing financial barriers.

Steps for KidSport Grant Application:

1. Enroll your child and pay for the program up front.
2. Apply for Kidsport funding
 - a. Once we receive the cheque, we will refund you for the cheque amount.
 - b. Alternatively, you can apply for funding, wait until cheque arrives and register your child at that point*.

*Please note, unless we have payment we are unable to hold a space for the child. Applications are reviewed by KidSport within 30 days (If the application is incomplete it will take much longer to review).

What does a KidSport Grant Cover?

- KidSport Calgary provides financial support up to \$250 per child, per calendar year towards sport registration fees. Calendar year runs from January 1 – December 31.
- If the child needs equipment we will make referral (upon approval of your KidSport application) to our partners at Comrie's Sport Equipment Bank.

Who is eligible to receive a KidSport Grant?

- Kids aged 18 and under are eligible to apply for a grant.
- KidSport considers the social and economic barriers facing the family when determining eligibility.
- Families that are on low income, unemployed, on AISH, currently receiving income support through provincial government are all considered eligible.
- Grants are allocated for sport registration fees and equipment; travel to competitions is not eligible for funding.
- A child can receive up to \$250 in a calendar year.

Required Documentation:

You will need to give KidSport one (1) of the following documents for each adult in the household:

- Child Health Benefits Letter
- Subsidized Housing
- Income Support (Inc. AISH)
- Canada Child Tax Benefit Notice (most recent tax year)
- Current Calgary or Airdrie Fee Assistance Card
- Notice of Assessment for the 2015 year, for each adult in the home (A copy can be obtained by calling 1-800-959-8281)
