

Genesis Centre Student Awards – Deadline June 30, 2024

Established to recognize youth leaders who demonstrate academic achievement as well as community involvement in Northeast Calgary.

The Genesis Centre core values surround community leadership and volunteerism. The Genesis Centre feels strongly that more needs and can be done to support those who are working to make Northeast Calgary a better place to live, study, work, and play.

Two awards are being made available to high school students across Calgary, although applicants from Northeast Calgary stand a greater chance of being selected. Each award is valued at \$1,500 applied directly to tuition.

Application process, eligibility, and guidelines:

- A Canadian citizen or permanent resident.
- Accepted and entering their first year of full-time undergraduate studies directly from Grade 12.
- Demonstrate school/community leadership through volunteerism and relevant extracurricular activities.
- Able to demonstrate financial need and academic achievement.
- Two letters of reference (school sponsor and community sponsor)
- Application forms can be found on the Genesis Centre website and are due on June 30th, 2024.
- All applications will be reviewed against scoring criteria by the Stakeholder Committee of the Genesis Centre Board (Northeast Centre of Community Society) from July 1st-31st, 2024 with formal notification given to all applicants on August 15th, 2024.
- Successful applicants will be required to do a short presentation at the Genesis Centre's Annual General Meeting in April 2025 highlighting their successful application.
